

ORDINANCE NO. 252-16-17

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Guin City Council have determined that traffic around the backside of Guin Elementary School needs to be controlled due to the large volume of cars dropping off and picking up children before and after school hours.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of Guin, Alabama, as follows:

1. That portion of 10th Street North which lies between 14th Avenue East and 15th Avenue East shall become a one-way street running in a Southerly direction only between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. and between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 3:30 p.m. on weekdays.

2. The speed limit shall be 15 miles per hour along that portion of 10th Street North which lies between 14th Avenue East and 15th Avenue East.

3. That appropriate traffic signs be placed on each end of the one-way portion of the alley.

4. Any motorist who travels in the wrong direction along the designated one-way portion of the alley, as described above shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Section 32-5A of the *Code of Alabama*, 1975, as amended, pursuant to City Ordinance 122-06-07 which adopts the provisions of Section 32-5A-87 of the *Code of Alabama*.

5. Any motorist who exceeds 15 miles per hour on that portion of 10th Street North which lies between 14th Avenue East and 15th Avenue East, shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Section 32-5A of the *Code of Alabama*, 1975, as amended, pursuant to City Ordinance 122-06-07 which adopts the provisions of Section 32-5A-171 of the *Code of Alabama*.
